**APRSCP is an Asia-Pacific focused non-governmental institution that:**

- Is represented by organizations and individuals involved in the development & promotion of sustainable consumption and production (SCP) in their respective nations.
- aims to enhance and strengthen regional cooperation in the development and implementation of SCP strategies.
- promotes best practices, programs, local initiatives, and lessons learned on SCP related projects in Asia and the Pacific region.



## Vision

To become a **sustainable regional network** and partnership, with its countries fully committed to the principles of Sustainable Consumption and Production.

## Mission

To provide leadership and support that will enhance **information flow and human resources development**, and will **strengthen public/private partnerships** to stimulate the **promotion and implementation of sustainable consumption and production policies, strategies and technologies** in the region.

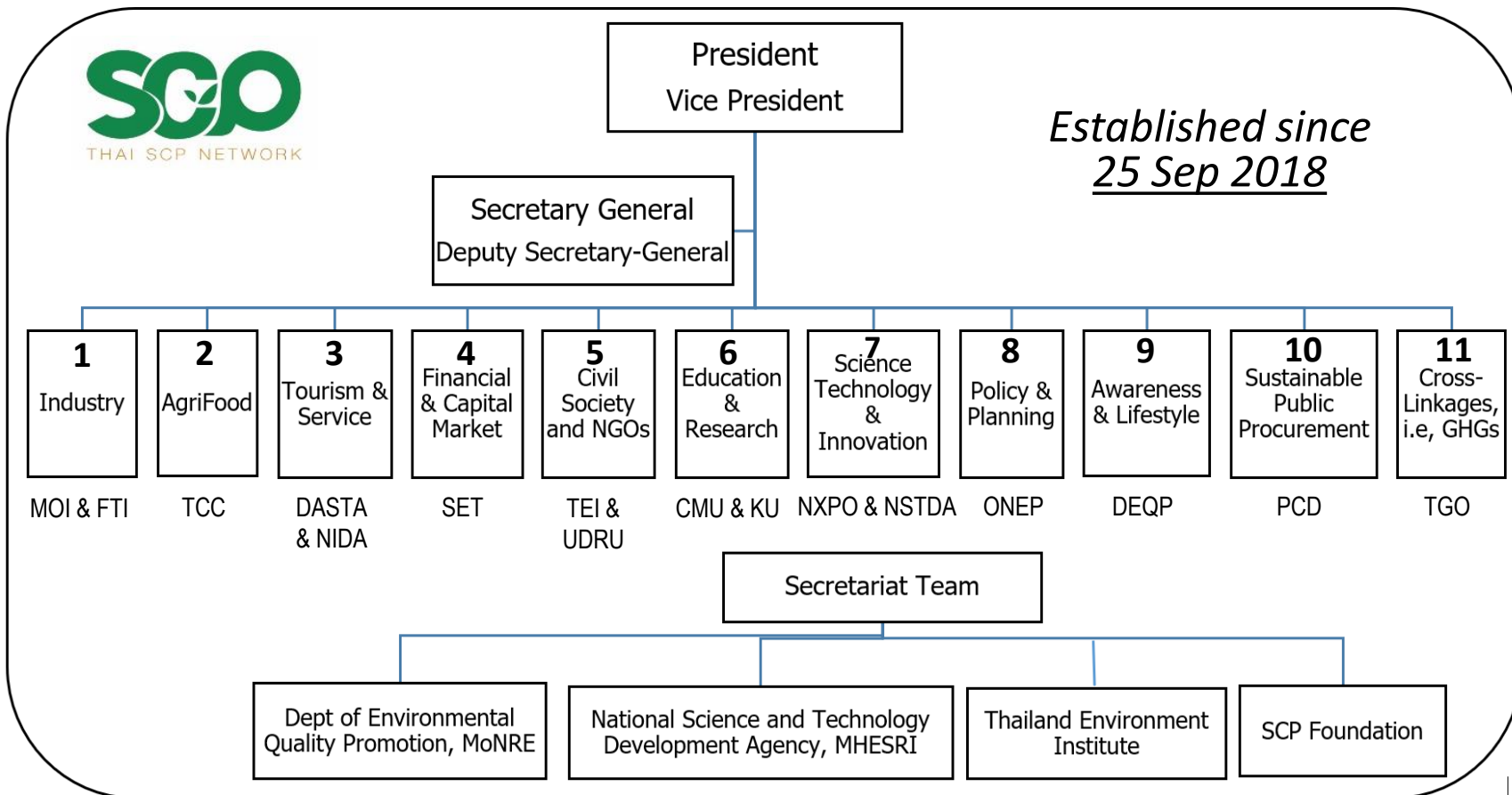
# CP → LCA → SCP Development in Thailand

# Structure of Thai SCP Network

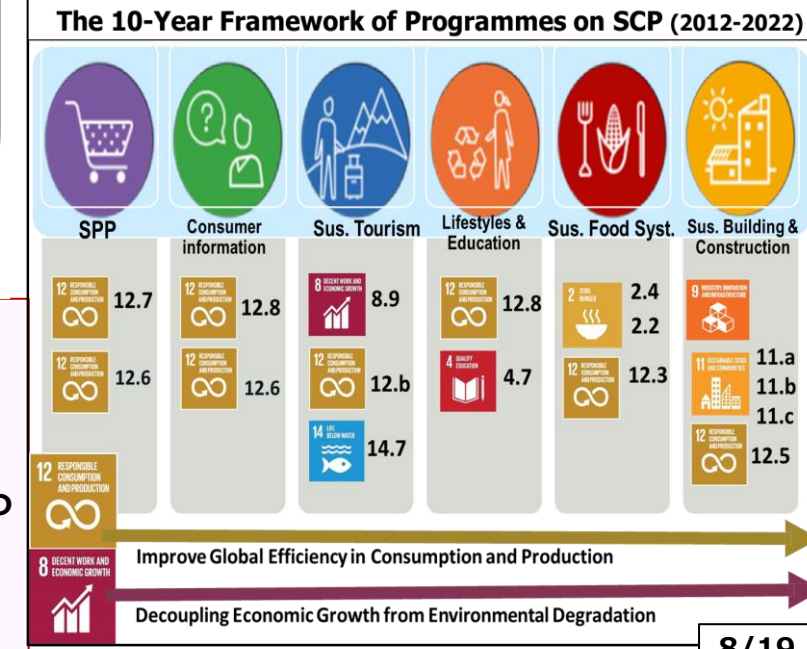

# Key Success Factors and Challenging Issues

## Key Success Factors to establish National SCP Network

1. Form a key working team (as the secretariat team) to plan the network structure, the working and funding scheme, including the main initiation activities and steps towards the long-term future of the network (corresponding to the national, regional and global SCP policy and plan)
2. Invite a respectable leader to be the network interim president
3. Invite appropriate key stakeholders (Public-Private-People-Partnerships: 4Ps) to lead each node of the network
4. Invite some key organizations (with SCP mission and budget) to support the network (*may involve as the secretary team*)
5. Reach out for further collaborations with other key organizations & networks (both domestic and oversea)



## Challenging issues

1. How to keep up the growing (1<sup>st</sup> 2-year) momentum of the network
2. How to have more new members (especially young generation) to join and contribute actively to the network
3. How to fulfill/meet the growing expectation of the stakeholders towards SDGs
4. How to work effectively to promote SCP with other national SCP networks, ASEAN, APRSCP (mother organization) and the One Planet Network

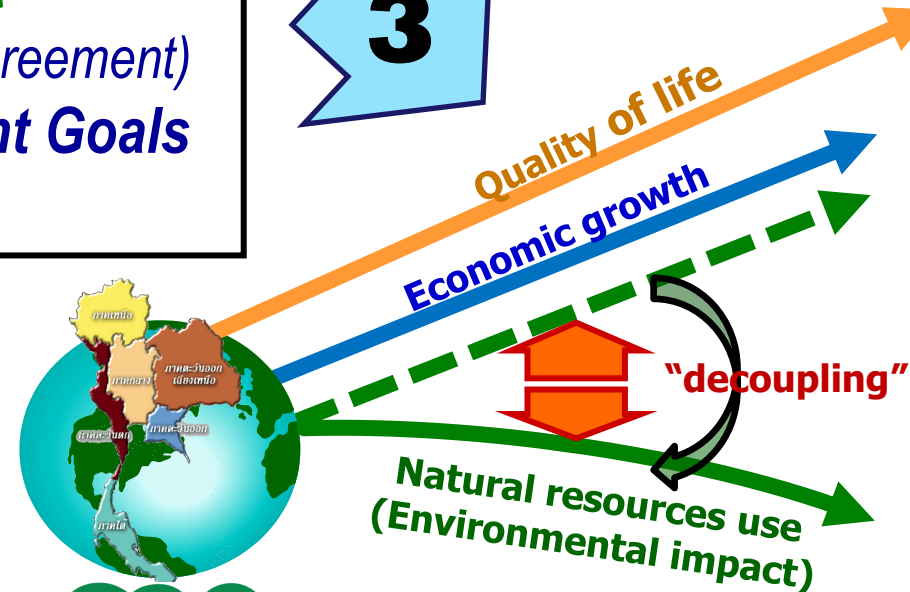
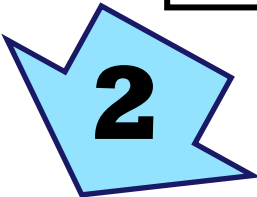

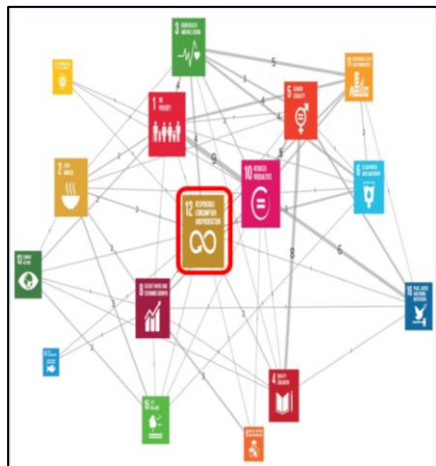
